For anyone who might be told first about a personal-data breach and needs the shape of the next 72 hours.

When you have worked through this, you will have: your notify-or-document triage verdict from the free assessment, and a 72-hour battle-card someone can hold at the start of an incident.

Your Free tier holds **1 document** (plus the interactive assessment). A “start here, in this order” guide only earns its place once there are several documents to sequence, so at this tier it is a single entry and a pointer onward.

The one guide

1. The GDPR 72-Hour Battle-Card

A short printable card laying out the sequence of the first 72 hours (awareness, risk assessment, coordination, submission), alongside the list of things not to do.

Reach for it when: Now, before anything happens. Give a copy to anyone who might be told first.

You finish with: A shared understanding of the sequence, and a card someone can hold at the start of an incident.

The interactive assessment

Not a document: a short decision-tree triage that returns a notify-or-document verdict and the 72-hour deadline.
